

## Parsons Printmaking Studio

### Orientations and Open Hours

The Printmaking Studio has Open Hours every day following morning classes. Please refer to the [Parsons Resources website](#) for current shop and class hours.

[Press reservations](#) must be made prior to use of the Vandercook, Etching presses, and Lithography presses.

Orientations are **required** for all students that are not currently enrolled in a printmaking class and would like to use the facility.

Orientations for Lithography, Spray Aquatint, Vandercook operation and Etching are offered ONLY to students that have taken a class that covered that technique. Orientations are provided for the first month of every semester and upon request through a consultation with a technician later in the semester.

Orientations for Silkscreen and Relief Printing are offered to all students. Scheduled orientations for Silkscreen and Relief are provided for the first two months of the semester and upon request through a consultation with a technician after that.

### Accessibility

The Printmaking Studio is open to students that are currently enrolled in a Printmaking course as well as students who have previously taken a printmaking course and/or fulfilled orientation obligations. Students will be required to present their ID to a technician in order to use the shop equipment or materials.

Students who have previously taken a printmaking course who are not currently enrolled in a class are **required** to take an orientation (per semester) specific to the equipment they will be using in order to utilize the facilities.

Students that have not taken any classes in our facility may have access to only the Silkscreen and Relief printing equipment and materials once they have taken an orientation (per semester).

Access to the silkscreen equipment and materials for students not currently enrolled in a silkscreen course requires a Screen Rental fee (outside screens are not allowed to be stored anywhere in our shop) as well a Studio Materials fee.

Classes that would like to use the Silkscreen or Relief equipment must schedule a consultation with a technician and make sure that all students either take the proper orientation before class use or schedule a time to take an orientation all together.
